

Dress Code

All students are expected to come to school in clean and properly fitting attire with proper hygiene and hair styled neatly. Daily personal grooming is important. Pride in one's appearance is the first step in gaining self-esteem and confidence. Moreover, limiting distractions associated with inappropriate or unusual dress and personal style promotes a positive learning environment. Parents will be contacted if a student cannot follow dress code guidelines or comes to school poorly groomed.

The student dress code is an important part of the school program and philosophy. Making a choice to attend the school, the student (with parent support) agrees to follow all dress code requirements. The dress code is not an option for the student or parent. Not choosing to follow the dress code may lead to suspension or expulsion.

The Lorain Preparatory High School Administration are the prime enforcers of this policy.

Students are required to wear proper attire daily.

The suggested uniform guidelines are as follows:

Bottoms (light khaki, medium khaki, dark khaki, black, brown, navy blue, gray)

Pants*, Shorts**, Jumpers**, Skorts**, Skirts**

*Pants must be in good condition without rips, tears or holes in them. Pants must fit appropriately at the waist.

**All shorts, jumpers, skorts, and skirts must not be any shorter than the end of the fingertips when arms are straight down. Students can wear leggings, stockings, tights, etc... underneath skirts or skorts.

Leggings, stockings, and/or tights are not to be worn by themselves as a pair of pants.

Tops (Any Solid Color)

Polo shirts, collared button-down shirts or blouse, turtlenecks, sweaters or plain solid color t-shirts. Spirit wear shirts are encouraged.

No hoodies, cut-off shirts, mesh shirts, spaghetti straps, crop tops, tube tops or tank tops.

Shoes

Dress shoes (various colors allowed) or tennis shoes (various colors allowed).

No sandals, flip-flops or shoes with wheels. All shoes must have covered toes and backing.

Belts

Solid color belt. ***No large belt buckles.***

General Appearance

No hats, bandanas, or visors.

Physical Education Class Dress Code

All grades:

Tennis shoes must be worn on scheduled physical education days.
